Membership Dues/Applications

Just a few reminders:

- 1.) ACRA members must pay annual dues by March 1 of each year. Members whose dues are delinquent as of June 1 of each year will be dropped from the membership roster and required to reapply for membership the following year. (38 members were dropped from the list in 2011)
- 2.) Any young member competing under a parent, or holding their own card, that will turn 18 before the Annual Reunion Rodeo must submit, or re-submit an application for membership by March 1, of that year and be accepted for membership to be eligible to compete in the rodeo.
- 3.) **All** applications for membership must be submitted by March 1 of each year. Late applications will be returned, or held until the following year. No exceptions to this rule. (To request an application please contact the rodeo secretary).
- 4.) Spouse membership-The legal spouse of a card holding ACRA member may compete in ACRA events, but must pay dues by March 1 of each year to be eligible. Children under the age of 18 may compete under their parent's card and are not required to pay dues. When turning 18 they must submit an application for membership of their own and be accepted for membership to be eligible to compete.
- 5.) Gold Card Qualifications- To qualify for a gold card, one must have been a member for 10 years, and must be 60 yrs or over. If you feel you qualify for a gold card please contact the secretary.
- 6.) Associate Membership-Any member who may, by vote of the Board of Directors, be selected for associate membership as a position of honor, because of their office or civic accomplishments which this organization feels should be recognized. Associate members shall be entitled to participate in association activities, except the rodeos, but shall have no vote.

2012 ACRA Dates

Although the dates are not officially set yet, the rodeo will probably remain in June around the same time as this year's. The spring event may possibly move to March, or Easter weekend. Look for the official dates on our website, or in future newsletters.
