Annual Rodeo Dates

Membership Dues

Starting this year each member will be charged \$5 for a replacement card at the rodeo. Each member is required to show proof of membership at the gate to get in free during the rodeo. So please bring your cards to the rodeo and carry them with you. If you come to the office for a replacement card at the rodeo you will be charged \$5 per card. All membership cards have been sent. If you have not received your 2014 membership card please send an email to cowpunchers@outlook.com so the secretary can research the reason why and send you a new one before the rodeo.

Membership Dues were due March 1st if you have not paid your dues for 2014 they are due immediately. Dues are now \$50 until June 1st. If you do not pay your annual dues by June 1st you will be dropped from the association and you will have to reapply for ACRA membership.

An update on membership cards. We decided to only send membership cards to kids 12 and older this year. There are so many young children in our association that we decided to try and save some money on membership cards for the kids since there is really no need for them to have a membership card. 
