RODEO WRAP UP

Wow!!! Thanks everyone for a great rodeo. It takes all of us to have a remarkable rodeo. The big news is the Calcutta Auction brought in over \$51,300 on Saturday night. What an amazing auction. The teams brought in \$33,060, Bronc Riders \$4,820 and Cowpuncher's Crisis Fund/Dieringer Family/Etc. \$13,445. Gonzo's Hawaiian Saddle Kimo had made was sold three times and brought in \$6,600 for the Cowpuncher's Crisis Fund. It was amazing to watch all the buyers biding and buying items. Thank you buyers for supporting such a great cause. We also want to thank all the people who donated items to the auction.

At the General Membership meeting we discussed once again when to hold the Annual Reunion Rodeo. Our association is divided in half. Half wants it in June and half wants it in July. After 319 votes 161 voted June 158 voted July. Rodeo dates is and always has been a board decision. The board wanted to get as accurate a vote as possible by having everyone vote with their entry forms. As everyone knows it is impossible to make every single member happy and with the association being divided almost equally what is the board to decide. The rodeo in June is more profitable for the association because we are able to draw a bigger paying gate crowd. It is a tough decision because there are pros and cons for each date but continuing to move the rodeo will hinder ACRA in the long run. It is imperative that we pick a date and keep that date. The board has decided to keep the rodeo in June from this point forward.

Our General Membership also voted on President, Vice President and four new Board Members. Clay Rogers was voted into a second term as President, Logan Anderson was voted in as Vice President and our four new board members are Dallas Howell, Encoh Malouff, Beano Kimball and Steve Dollarhide. Our returning Board Members are Vic Howell and Toby Foote. Congratulations and welcome aboard!! We thank you and appreciate the time and effort you are giving to ACRA.

Our entries overall were up just a little from last year. The biggest growth event was the Ribbon Roping by 24 teams. The Gymkhana was also up by about 30 kids. Kristen Roer has done a great job with the Gymkhana and we appreciate her time putting the Gymkhana on for all our children. The Dummy Roping was a huge hit this year after the Saturday slack. We have heard great things about having the dummy roping in the arena. We will keep the dummy roping the same time next year. Kristy Dollarhide has done an outstanding job heading up the dummy roping for many years now. Kristy does many things for our association behind the scene. Thank you Kristy for everything you do and for always stepping in when we really need someone.

Our main issue this year at the rodeo was underage drinking and young kids partying in the parking lot/camping area after the dance was over. This is going to be a huge issue for ACRA if we as an association don't get it under control. We have to report to the liquor board and get approved every year for our liquor license by the City of Williams Chief of Police. We as an association next year need to come together and help monitor underage drinking. We understand not all the offenders are actual members of our association or even child of members of our association but either way we need to put a stop to the heavy parting after the dance. We will be working with the City of Williams Chief of Police to find ways to better monitor this issue but as an association we can also help by asking underage kids not to drink and breaking up after dance parties in the parking lot. If there is major issues going on please let a board member know so we can try to diffuse the situation before it becomes an issue. We will remind you of this issue again next year come rodeo time.

Overall the rodeo was great. Everything went just as planned. It is always nice when we can come together and make the rodeo what it was meant to be a "Reunion".

MEMBERSHIP INFO

2015 ACRA Membership Dues can be sent now for next year. Dues sent by March 1st, 2015 are \$30. If your spouse will be competing in the rodeo please send an additional \$30 for their dues. If dues are received after March 1st they will be \$50 each and if dues are not received by June 1st, 2015 you will be dropped from membership and need to reapply. ENTRY FORMS 101

We are going to try something new this year.....give advice on how to properly fill out an ACRA Entry Form.

- 1. **ALL** once again **ALL Contestants** must have their **OWN** entry form: Including little girls and spouses running in the ribbon roping, 12 & Under ropers, mugger in the Wild Cow Milking....Everyone!!
- All entry forms must be signed. This is a waiver that has to be signed by every competitor or guardian of the competitor.
- 3. Pay for your own entry form. If you are paying both sides then a NEW entry form needs to be filled out for your partner. You should **NEVER** pay both sides on one entry form.
- 4. **CALL YOUR PARTNERS BEFORE YOU ENTER!!!** Honestly you would be amazed at how many entries are received and their partners never entered. Simple phone call. If you don't have your partner's number call Carrie Gross 602-510-4940 and she might be able to help you.
- 5. Entry Forms can be copied. Please make copies of your entry form!! If you need another entry form mailed to you please call Carrie Gross 602-510-4940 and she will be more than happy to get one, two or three off in the mail to you.
