ENTRY FORMS 101

We are going to try something new this year.....give advice on how to properly fill out an ACRA Entry Form.

- 1. <u>ALL</u> once again <u>ALL</u> Contestants must have their <u>OWN</u> entry form: Including little girls and spouses running in the ribbon roping, 12 & Under ropers, mugger in the Wild Cow Milking....Everyone!!
- 2. All entry forms must be signed. This is a waiver that has to be signed by every competitor or guardian of the competitor.
- **3.** Pay for your <u>OWN</u> entry form. If you are paying both sides then a NEW entry form needs to be filled out for your partner. You should NEVER pay both sides on one entry form.
- 4. <u>CALL YOUR PARTNERS BEFORE YOU ENTER!!!</u> Honestly you would be amazed at how many entries are received and their partners never entered. A simple phone call. If you don't have your partner's number call Carrie Gross 602-510-4940 and she might be able to help you.
- **5.** Entry Forms can be copied. Please make copies of your entry form!! If you need another entry form mailed to you please call Carrie Gross 602-510-4940 and she will be more than happy to get one, two or three off in the mail.

New Rodeo Event

The board has decided to try a new event this year. It will be open to both male and female riders between the age of 13 and 15 at time of rodeo. It will have the same rules as the Cowboy Bronc Riding only difference is they will ride cows or bigger steers. Entry fee will be \$65. Top 6 will ride in the short round on Sunday. Here are the rules –

▶ Jr. Bronc Riding: Contestants must be 13 through 15 at time of the event. Everyday saddles only, no freaks. Stirrups leathers through D-rings are NOT permissible, NO BINDS. Spurs – no locked rowels. Rider must provide halter and rein. Disqualification for touching any part of the horse or equipment with free hand, losing a stirrup, or bucking off before the eight second buzzer sounds. Time will be stopped at the moment of any disqualification. A partial ride may be used to fill a short-round, but cannot be used for payouts.

Rodeo Parking/Camping/Changes

Let's clarify a few things - 1st we HAVE NOT lost our liquor license as of yet. That is what we are trying NOT to do. That is why we are implementing wrist bands, new parking, and dance fees, etc. this year at the rodeo. It does not matter who can get a liquor license if the Williams Chief of Police does not sign off on the liquor license we will not get a liquor license. 2nd The City of Williams, its businesses, Chief of Police and Williams residents want Arizona Cowpuncher's Reunion Rodeo in Williams, Arizona. They are doing everything possible to make sure we stay in Williams. They love us being there as much as we love being there. 3rd We as a board understand the slight inconvenience the new rules are going to be, but honestly it is really not as big of a deal as it is being made. We are still going to have a rodeo, we are still going to have a beer garden, a dance, Calcutta Auction, jackpot roping, camping, and food; everything will be the same except a little different parking and wearing a wrist band. So PLEASE don't read more into the situation then what it is. We are going to have to make some changes. These are changes that have been surfacing for a while. Let's all come together as an association and make the best of the situation. 4th These changes ARE NOT being brought on by the current board. We have an amazing Board of Directors. They work extremely hard at getting everything in order for the Spring Roping and Annual Rodeo. They agree as much as anyone that our liquor license and the beer garden are extremely important to our association. The revenue we make through the beer garden, dance, sponsors and admission gate help our association to continue having a Spring Roping/Bronc Riding and Annual Rodeo. 5th You are able to bring your panels and set them up if you prefer. We made a suggestion if you are able to buy a stall for the weekend that would help the parking situation but if you want to bring panels, bring panels.

Now to the good news. We have freed up 9 acres right across from the arena. We are going to make this the spectator parking and camping area. This will free up the whole arena area for just ACRA members. Now you can park wherever you would like within the rodeo grounds. You will still need to show ID and your membership card to get into the rodeo grounds to park and camp. We are NOT going to allow any non-members to park within the rodeo grounds. All non-members will have to park on the opposite side of the road. This being said. If you have family and friends who want to go and watch the Gymkhana in the second arena they are more than welcome to. If you have friends who want to have breakfast with you at your camp in the ACRA parking area that is also fine. They just won't be able to park on the rodeo grounds and they won't be able to camp on the rodeo grounds. They will have to walk to your campsite from the spectator side. Also for the Calcutta and dance everyone who is not a member will have to park in the spectator parking area and walk across. We are trying to separate the ACRA members from all non-members and we feel this is the best way to accomplish our goals. We are also hoping to cut down on underage drinking on the rodeo grounds and the dance after parties on the rodeo grounds. Your help and cooperation is greatly appreciated. We have included a map to help you understand where the new spectator parking lot will be and what is open for ACRA members.


