RODEO WRAP UP

Overall everything was great this year. The City of Williams was very happy with our event and our members. We have worked very hard the past couple years implementing changes to better our association and those changes seem to be working. A couple issues are members giving wristbands to kids under the age of 21. There is a reason why we wristband everyone over the age of 21. If underage drinking was not an issue we would have not implemented the wristband policy. Please do not give your wristband to anyone under the age of 21. Also if you are under the age of 21 DO NOT buy beer from the beer garden and DO NOT drink at the beer garden and dance. Go find your beer somewhere else. You are personally putting the association's liquor license in jeopardy. If it is that important to get drunk or buzzed do it at camp. If you are caught with a wristband and you are under age you will be removed from ACRA membership and asked to leave the rodeo. If you are caught giving your wristband to a person who is under the age of 21 you will be removed from membership and asked to leave the rodeo. We have been very patient in asking for everyone to follow the rules but when our association is being put at risk we will have to step up and protect it. Vote on Rodeo Gymkhana Day: PLEASE RESPOND BY NOVEMBER 1ST, 2016

It has been discussed to move the Annual Rodeo Gymkhana to Thursday starting at 10 a.m. or 10:30 a.m before the Thursday Jackpot. The hopes is to have the Gymkhana over right before the Thursday Jackpot starts. It will still be held in the small arena. The discussion has been made that this would free up parents and horses that are being used Friday morning during the Team Tying. We want to get our members opinion on this change. The Board of Directors want to make the best decision for our association. Please only email Carrie with your vote regarding the Gymkhana and have emails sent by November 1st, 2016 if you have an opinion.

All Around Title:

There has been some questions about the All Around Title and who is eligible for what award. You can qualify for only 1 All Around Title even if you fall into two different categories. The way the All Around Titles are figured is by age. Explanation – If you are 12 and under you are only able to compete for the 12 and under All Around Title even if you made more points than the 16 and under All Around winner. Same goes for the ladies, if you are 50 and over you are only able to compete for the 50 and over All Around Cowgirl Title you are not eligible for the All Around Cowgirl Title. Gentlemen over 50 are not able to compete for the All Around Cowboy. The All Around Title you are competing for is determined by your age.

*****DUES INCREASE** IMPORTANT Membership Information:**

The Board of Directors during the July 2016 board meeting voted to increase membership dues to \$40 per member, this includes competing spouses. This increase will go into effect for the 2017 membership year. The ACRA Board of Directors feel the increase is needed to help with the increase in operating cost.

2017 ACRA Membership Dues can be sent now or any time before March 1st, 2017. Please use the form enclosed when sending your dues. It is extremely important that you fill out the form completely with birthdates and clarification if the person is male or female. This is all information we would like in our database so during the rodeo we know what all around category each contestant falls into.

Dues sent by March 1st, 2017 are \$40. If your spouse will be competing in the rodeo please send an additional \$40 for their dues. If dues are received after March 1st they will be \$75 each and if dues are not received by June 1st, 2017 you will be dropped from membership and need to reapply.

New membership applications must be received before March 1st, 2017. The ACRA Board of Directors will vote on new members during the March ACRA Board Meeting.
