RODEO WRAP UP

We as an association did a great job this year. Everyone is getting use to the parking and wrist bands. We had no huge issues this years and Chief Nixon along with the City of Williams are ecstatic with how are members are representing themselves and our association. It is great that everyone has come together. Thank you all for your patience and understanding over the past few years. Wristbands, parking passes, security are the new normal for our association so please expect these from now on at each rodeo.

The General Membership meeting was held on Saturday by the tan barn. Logan Anderson and Beano Kimball were voted in again as President and Vice President. They have done a great job over the past years and we are grateful to have them back again. Three new board members were voted to a 2 year term. Cody Tillery, Linc Bundy and J.R. Murdock. A tie between J.R. Murdock and Justyn Jones caused a second vote between the two with J.R. Murdock winning the tie breaker vote. Welcome aboard gentlemen. We are excited to have you as board members.

Other discussions during the meeting were the need of a better water truck to help keep the dust down. We understand that a bigger and better water truck is needed and the board will discuss this need. June is dry and we know more water all around the rodeo grounds is a must. We will work on this issue and try to better the situation next year. It was brought up again about moving the rodeo back to July. This issue has been hammered out over and over for many years. A full membership vote was taken in 2014 and by membership vote the rodeo was permanently moved to the month of June. The voting was very close with 161 voting for June and 153 voting for July. We as a board understand both sides of the discussion and have visited in depth about the rodeo being held in June or July. The vote was sent to every active member of our association and returned by mail. At this time we will continue to host the rodeo in June. We understand with the closeness in votes that our association is divided in respect to when the rodeo should be held so we must stand by the membership vote and keep the rodeo in June. Handicap railing on a section of the grandstands was also brought up and we will bring this to the attention of the City of Williams. A few rodeo dedication suggestions were given during the meeting as well. We always appreciate input and ideas from our membership. Always a highlight to the rodeo is the Saturday Night Calcutta Auction. The Bill Owen 5 Steer Calcutta brought in \$47,815 while the Bronc Riding Calcutta was \$11,875 and the Cowpuncher's Crisis Fund raised \$6,260. Overall Calcutta was up from 2016. We enjoy all the buyers who came out to bid. It is a fun night filled with laughs, good times and great friends.

The gymkhana was moved to Thursday morning before the jackpot. We have heard from many families and the consensus seems to be that everyone enjoyed the new day and time. We had a great turn out for the gymkhana and the kids did a great job. Cassie Hambrick did and exceptional job with prizes and organizing the event. 
