rodeo to July this year. The health and well being of our members are top priority and that was a major concern in their decision. The uncertainty of the country being open, following CDC regulations, sponsors and local business having enough time to rebound from the shutdown, liability concerns and tourist and spectators being able to join our event were also discussion points. With everything going on it was decided it is in the best interest of our association and its members to move the 2020 rodeo to July. The rodeo will go on as normal. It will start with the Gymkhana Thursday morning followed by the Jackpot and then Team Tying morning slack Friday morning at 6:50 a.m. You will find the detailed rodeo schedule in this newsletter. Please read the newsletter in its entirety as there have been some changes to the rodeo this year. We hope to see everyone in July!!

2020 RODEO INFORMATION

The 2020 Annual Reunion Rodeo will be July 23rd thru 26th. Entry forms are enclosed and must be **POSTED MARKED** by July 3rd, 2020 if you are planning on competing in the rodeo. There are a few changes to the rodeo schedule this year. Thursday events will be same as last year starting with the Gymkhana Thursday morning at 10 a.m. and the Jackpot Team Roping books close at 12:30 p.m. rope at 1 p.m.

The board voted to add an event for the 12 and under kids. This year they will be able to breakaway rope. The boys and girls will compete against each other in the age group. The entry fees will be \$30 a roper. The 12 & under Breakaway slack will be right after the Ladies Breakaway slack. Depending on how many kids we have entered will determine if there will be any in the performance.

Friday morning slack will be a little different this year. The Team Tying, Century and Both Ends Over 60 will complete both the first round and short round Friday morning. The Team Tying, Century and Both Ends Over 60 will complete the first round just like normal. Team Tying will start at 6:50 a.m. followed by the 1st round of the Century and then the 1st round of the Both Ends Over 60. Once the Both Ends Over 60 1st round slack is over the short round of the Team Tying will start followed by the Century short round and then the Both Ends Over 60 short round. The 16 & Under Mix will also be completed during the Saturday morning Slack. The 1st round of the 16 & Under Mix will start at 6:50 a.m. Saturday morning and the short round will follow the 12 & Under Saturday morning slack. There will NOT be any Team Tying, Century, Both Ends Over 60 or 16 & Under Mix during the Sunday Performance.

General Membership meeting MOVED to Sunday July 26th at 11:00 a.m. It has been so hard to get our members to attend our annual General Membership meeting. Throughout the years it has been held at different times trying to get more involvement from the members. The meeting is particularly important to our association as we vote on President, Vice President, Board Members, discuss happening within the association and always open the floor for members to voice their opinion. We ask that everyone please attend. The meeting will be held under the Calcutta tent. Come make your voice hear!!

If you are over the age of 21 please get a wristband. IF YOU ARE NOT 21 DO NOT WEAR AN OVER 21-YEAR-OLD WRISTBAND. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT WITH AN OVER 21 WRISTBAND YOU WILL BE REMOVED FROM MEMBERSHIP FROM ACRA FOR 2 YEARS AND WILL HAVE TO REAPPLY. If you have your wristband you will not need to carry your membership card with you. Your wristband will allow you to park for free and allow you through the performance gate each day. PLEASE come get your wristband THURSDAY at the secretary/entry office, AFTER Thursday you will pick up your wristband at the Beer Garden. If your wristband comes off, please bring it with you so you can exchange it for a new one. We expect everyone to keep their wristband all weekend. If your child is over the age of 10, they will need their ACRA Membership card to get into the rodeo performance. Please contact Carrie Gross to request a membership card if you have not received one. Everyone will need their 2020 ACRA Membership card.

Thursday Jackpot books will **CLOSE at 12:30 p.m.**!!! The jackpot is a pick and draw and once the entries have closed, we are not able to take late entries. Please plan accordingly to make sure you get entered. **The Calcutta Auction will start promptly at 5:30 p.m. Saturday night**. Please come early to get your buyer number if you plan on buying any teams, bronc riders or auction items. It is much easier on the ladies working the Calcutta if you get your buyer number before the start of the Calcutta.

Gymkhana entries are due **July 3rd, 2020**. **Remember the Gymkhana will be held Thursday morning.** Please make sure you mail your entries to Cassie Hambrick by July 3rd. A BIG THANK YOU to Cassie for putting on the Gymkhana again this year for our children. We also want to thank all our sponsors who support the Gymkhana. Without the Gymkhana sponsors we would not be able to give great prizes to all the kids.

ENTRY FORMS 101

CALL YOUR PARTNER BEFORE YOU ENTER WITH THEM - VERY POSSIBLE THEY MAY NOT ENTER!!

- **1.** <u>EVERY</u> Contestants must have their <u>OWN</u> entry form: Including <u>LITTLE GIRLS</u> and <u>SPOUCES</u> running in the ribbon roping, 12 & under ropers, mugger in the Wild Cow Milking.... <u>EVERYONE!!</u>
- **2.** All <u>ENTRY FORMS</u> must be <u>SIGNED</u>. This is a waiver that must be signed by every competitor or guardian of the competitor.
- **3.** Pay for your **OWN** entry form. If you are paying both sides, then a NEW entry form needs to be filled out for your partner. You should NEVER pay both sides on one entry form.
- **4.** Once again <u>CALL YOUR PARTNERS BEFORE YOU ENTER!!!</u> Honestly you would be amazed at how many entries are received and their partners never entered. A simple phone call. If you don't have your partner's number call Carrie Gross 602-510-4940 and she might be able to help you.
- **5.** <u>Entry Forms can be copied</u>. Please make copies of your entry form!! If you need another entry form you can print one off the website at azcowpunchers.com or call Carrie Gross 602-510-4940 and she will be more than happy to get one, two or three off in the mail.
