Membership Information

2020 ACRA Membership Dues can be sent now or any time before March 1st, 2020. Please use the form enclosed when sending your dues. It is extremely important that you fill out the form completely with birthdates and clarification if the person is male or female. This is all information we would like in our database so during the rodeo we know what all around category each contestant falls into.

Dues sent by March 1st, 2020 are \$40. If your spouse will be competing in the rodeo please send an additional \$40 for their dues. If dues are received after March 1st, they will be \$75 each and if dues are not received by June 1st, 2020 you will be dropped from membership and need to reapply.

New membership applications <u>MUST</u> be received before <u>March 1st, 2020</u>. The ACRA Board of Directors will vote on new members during the March ACRA Board Meeting. This will be the only meeting new membership applications will be discussed and voted on.

Rodeo Changes, Updates and Information

We truly appreciate everyone voicing their opinions during our Annual General Membership Meeting held at the rodeo. It is important to the Board that they hear what our members are thinking. If there are items, issues, or concerns you have, the Annual General Membership Meeting is a great place voice those.

During the September ACRA Board Meeting many items were discussed that were brought to the Boards attention during the June 2019 General Membership Meeting. The items discussed were having an incentive in the Century, Overall All Around – "Top Hand Award", Dress code for women, honoring Van Thundercloud, finishing the Mix, Team Tying, Both Ends Over 60 and Century during the slack and adding an incentive breakaway roping.

Let's start with the Century Team Roping! The board agreed to add a #9.5 incentive to the Century roping. Going forward starting with the spring roping there will be a #9.5 incentive in the Century team roping.

Starting at the 2020 Annual Reunion Rodeo a new award will be added to the rodeo, the Overall "Top Hand" award. This award will be given to the cowboy or cowgirl who has the most points overall in more than one event. There will be no age cap on this award, it is anyone's to win. The winner of the "Top Hand" award must have points in both a roping event and a rough stock event. Rough stock event will include Wild Horse Race and Bronc Riding. The award will be given during the annual awards banquet after the rodeo Sunday afternoon.

After a lengthy discussion the ACRA Board of Directors voted unanimously to leave the ladies dress code as currently stated in the Bylaws of the Arizona Cowpunchers Reunion Association, Article IV item 1. Western attire must be worn while competing. Women excepted.

Mr. Thundercloud has been watering the arena and around the arena for years now. It was brought up by multiple members during the General Membership meeting that he should be recognized for years of service. The Board also agreed, and Mr. Thundercloud will be recognized during the 2020 General Membership meeting.

There has been talk, discussion, rumblings for years about finishing some of the events that are not part of the performance during the events' slack. Trying to place the short round of these events during the Sunday performance makes the Sunday performance much longer. There is also the discussion that many members can only get away from the ranch for a day and this could allow some members the ability to compete. Completing certain events during the slack will allow the awards banquet to start earlier and will help the stock contractors immensely as well. After much discussion the following events will be held in their entirety during the slack. Friday morning slack – Team Tying, Century, Both Ends Over 60. Saturday morning slack – 16 & Under Mix. The 1st round of each event will be performed as usual then after the entire morning slack is completed the short rounds will be completed. The Team Tying Short Round will be after the Both Ends Over 60 Short Round. The 16 and Under Mix Short Round will be held after the 12 & Under Saturday morning Slack. Your patience is very much appreciated during this first year of changes.

A new event will be added to this year's annual rodeo. Youth Breakaway Roping. This event will follow the same rules as the Ladies Breakaway except it will be open to 12 & Under boys and girls. The event will be \$30 a roper. Ladies Breakaway will be 13 and over ladies only for \$45 a roper. Keeping the family aspect of Arizona Cowpuncher's Reunion Association is very important to the ACRA Board of Directors.

2020 ACRA Spring Team Roping, Bronc Riding & Steer Riding

March 28th & 29th, 2020 – Wickenburg, AZ Everett Bowman Arena

We will Calcutta off **ONLY** the Bronc Riders at 5:30 p.m. Saturday evening and ride steers directly after the Calcutta. The Bronc Riding will start at 7 p.m. We will also be taking entries for the Team Tying all day Saturday. Books for the Team Tying will close at 3 p.m. Saturday afternoon. The format will be as follows:

Team Tying Starts at 8:00 a.m. sharp Team Tying (w/#9.5 inc.) - \$50 per roper, enter 3X – Books Close Saturday 3 p.m.

12 & Under – \$10 per roper, enter 5X

All Girl – \$30 per roper, enter 5X

Century (w/#9.5 inc.) - \$40 per roper, enter 4X

16 & Under Mix (w/#9.5 inc.) – \$40 per roper, enter 4X

Pick One Draw One (w/#9.5 inc.) – \$80 per roper, enter 2X (for 4 runs)

Buckles will be awarded in the Steer Riding, Bronc Riding, Team Tying and Team Tying Incentive. Bronc Riding books are pre-enter and close March 15th, 2020. Email Carrie at
